

# Who can apply for the scholarships?



The main goal of the scholarships is to give four young people the opportunity to experience life at sea, in addition to spreading the word about sailing and sail training.

To get the most out of the scholarships and the experience, there is some terms and conditions set in terms of who is allowed to apply. Applicants that do not meet these requirements will therefore not be evaluated.

## Applicants **MUST**:

- Be between 18-25 years of age. You must turn 18 before the beginning of the voyage and cannot turn 26 during the trip.
- Have valid ID.
- Speak both Norwegian and English.
- Have booked a trip for the Tall Ships Races 2026 (with your ship of choice) **before** the application is submitted. A copy of the booking confirmation needs to be attached with the application before it is sent in. If the application is submitted without a booking confirmation, it will not be evaluated.
- Be able to document the voyage, preferably in the form of pictures. Applicants must give the scholarship manager the right to use the documentation. For instance, the pictures will be used in presentations and social media related to sailing and sail training.
- Work with social media during the voyage. The requirement for this is set to every other day and will take about one hour (maximum) each time. The tasks are mainly about writing small reports every other day about how life is onboard a sailing vessel.
  - If the scholarship receiver does not conduct the voyage, the whole scholarship must be returned to Vitamin Sea Sail. This also counts for regattas being cancelled or if the ship you booked your trip with chooses to cancel your voyage.

## Worth mentioning:

- Remember to check your travel insurance. Injuries can happen on board a sailing vessel and Vitamin Sea Sail is not responsible for any injuries or economical replacements if an incidence should occur during the voyage.
- The scholarship covers up to 260 EUR (3000 NOK) of the voyage.
- Unforeseen circumstances may arise, and the scholarship receiver must return the whole scholarship if he/she/they do not execute the voyage, for whatever reason.
- Make sure that you have your passport and other traveling documents in order.
- You can expect a response to your application **within April 1<sup>st</sup>**.
